The University of Central Asia (UCA) recognizes the critical role that data plays in enhancing our impact. Improving the standardization, quality, and consistency of the program data we collect, along with the systems and practices used to manage and analyze this data, is a top priority. We are seeking a consultant to strengthen UCA's institutional capacity to effectively collect, manage, analyze, and utilize program data. This role at UCA'S School of Professional and Continuing Education (SPCE) will significantly contribute to UCA's goal of becoming a data-driven organization, thereby enhancing the quality of programming for the communities we serve.



## Responsibilities

- Supporting local staff to develop project proposals
- Supporting the design and implementation of an integrated program data architecture pilot. This initiative focuses on standardizing and centralizing data collection, management, storage, analysis, and usage across Kyrgyz Republic, with potential expansion to other UCA countries.
- Reviewing existing data collection tools, identifying opportunities for standardization, and refining data collection methodologies.
- Developing a comprehensive library of digitized survey tools within a shared data collection platform (e.g., ONA).
- Assisting country units in developing data visualization dashboards using Microsoft Power BI.
- Supporting the preparation and facilitation of learning sessions for the Results and Learning Community of Practice.
- Conducting training sessions on digital platforms such as Power BI, ONA, Kobo, and Salesforce to enhance data capacity within UCA Country Offices.
- Drafting "Insights for Action" stories that highlight the use of data in decision-making processes in Kyrgyz Republic.
- Supervising short-term interns and volunteers as appropriate.
- Supporting the data architecture pilot in collaboration with partners and Aga Khan Development Network (AKDN) agencies in Kyrgyz Republic.
- Assisting in the design and implementation of Data Quality Assessments (DQAs) at both the UCA and implementing agency levels.

## **Required Qualifications and Experience**

- A degree in international development, development studies, social sciences, data science, data analytics, or a related field.
- Significant experience in project/program-related data collection, management, monitoring, evaluation, and analysis.
- Familiarity with digital data collection platforms (e.g., SAP, Kobo, ONA Data, Microsoft Forms).
- Proficiency in data analytics platforms, particularly Microsoft Power BI.



- Competence in Microsoft applications including Word, Outlook, OneDrive, and Power Apps.
- Strong written and verbal communication skills in English.
- Proven ability to manage multiple tasks simultaneously, prioritize effectively, and meet deadlines.
- Experience in the not-for-profit sector is a plus.
